To Our Green Chimneys Families,

We have received notification that three individuals at our Brewster campus have tested positive for COVID-19. These individuals were last on campus Sunday, December 5<sup>th</sup>; Tuesday, December 7<sup>th</sup>; and Wednesday, December 8<sup>th</sup>, respectively and are currently isolating. All staff and families of students who had close contact have been notified and are following appropriate health protocols.

Please note that COVID-19 is still present in our region, and cases are rising with the increase in indoor activities and holiday gatherings. It is possible to contract COVID, regardless of vaccination status.

Green Chimneys is coordinating with the Putnam County Department of Health and closely monitoring the situation with all individuals on campus. We continue to follow all safety guidelines and do not expect to suspend in-person instruction at this time.

Parents should continue to monitor their child each day for symptoms of COVID-19, which could include fever, loss of taste or smell, headache, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, fatigue, congestion or runny nose, body aches and/or nausea.
